Dementia is not a single disease; it's an overall term — like heart disease — that covers a wide range of specific medical conditions. Did you know that there are over 100 types of Dementia? The most common type of Dementia is Alzheimer's disease, accounting for 40-70% of all Dementia related diagnoses.

Dementia

Dementia is an umbrella term that descrives a collection of symptoms that are caused by disorders affecting the brain. It is not one specific disease. Dementia affects thinking, behaviour and the ability to perform every day tasks, and brain function is affected enough to interfere with the person's normal social or working life. The most common type of dementia is Alzheimer's disease.
