

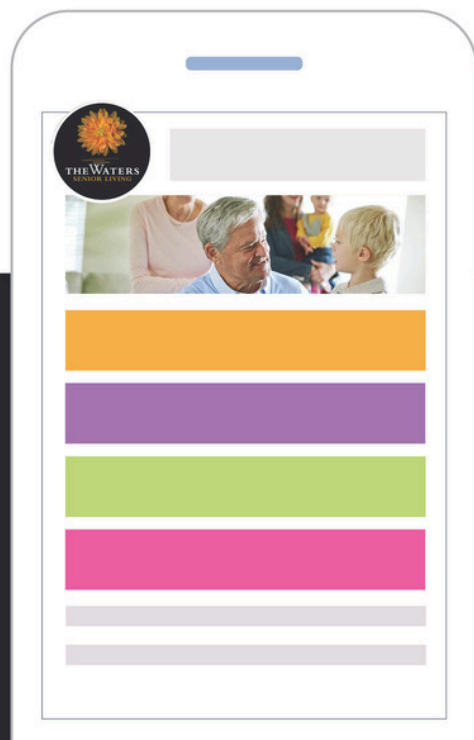
Hello Friends,

CLASSIC PINEAPPLE UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE



BUTTERY CAKE TOPPED WITH PINEAPPLE AND CHERRIES—SIMPLE AND TIMELESS.

- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 can pineapple slices
- ½ cup butter (melted)
- ¾ cup brown sugar
- Maraschino cherries

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 350°F. Melt the butter and spread it evenly in the bottom of a cake pan, then sprinkle the brown sugar over the butter. Arrange the pineapple slices on top of the sugar and place a cherry in the center of each slice. Prepare the yellow cake mix according to the package directions and pour the batter evenly over the fruit. Bake for 40–45 minutes, until the cake is golden and set. Allow the cake to cool briefly, then carefully invert it onto a serving plate.
